- Request to have the sanctuary light burn in memory of a loved one for one week. Sanctuary candles are in St. Joseph, St. Mary & St. Mary's Chapel. (\$10)

Masses may be cancelled and rescheduled at any point during the year based on Fr. Chris' vacation scheduling. Also, in booking Masses, you may want consider an "Unannounced Mass" in place of an "Announced Mass". Unannounced Masses are \$10 and are offered as Fr. Chris' intention when available. Whether announced or unannounced, the intention is made and God's grace is granted to the deceased.

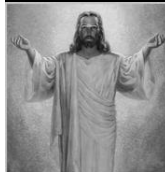
RCIA
