### **Called to Kingship starts Friday October 20<sup>th</sup>.**

Recently, Bishop Barron commented on the parable of the sowing of seeds.

It was about the seed that falls on the path, and some withers for lack of nutrients. For him it revealed an obstacle to our efforts at our own growth in faith development.

His point was that one of the blocks of receiving the seed is lack of understanding, lack of education in the ways of the Spirit. The fundamentals have to be in place before the word can be accepted. What a prophetic word to our time! Israel was the extensive and complex preparation for the reception of the Word. Are we enriching our soil for the growth of understanding our faith? This is reflected in the opening of the book of Genesis and followed in the second chapter of Samuel.

Starting on Friday October 20<sup>th</sup> and six successive Fridays, Fr. Kearney and Deacon Karl Pietkiewicz will be facilitating an opportunity for faith enhancement at St. Joseph's Church in Glasco. Beginning with Mass celebrated at 12 noon, followed with a fellowship pot luck luncheon and then a viewing and discussion of Bishop Barron's new series **David the King**. David's 'Called to Kingship' which we will reflect on, foreshadows the Kingship of the Creator and our own journey in faith.
