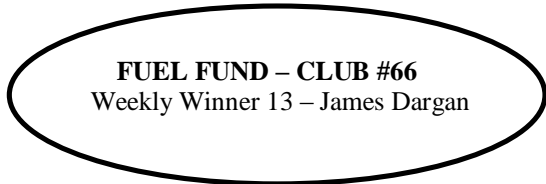

On June 18, 2015, the Vatican issued *Laudato Si', Praise Be to You*, Pope Francis's encyclical on caring for creation.
