**PARISH OFFICE HOURS**

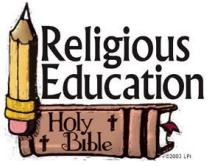

Beginning Monday, Sept. 12, 2016, the Catholic Bible School Program, sponsored by the Archdiocesan Catechetical Office, will be holding classes on Monday evenings from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., at the Church of St. Denis, 604 Beekman Road, Hopewell Junction, N.Y. This program exists because there is joy and hope in the Bible! Being grounded in our beliefs leads us to a deeper relationship with God and an evolving sense of life's meaning. Intense study of the Bible brings us to life-changing personal growth in spirituality and service. This program is for adults who are seeking "something more" in their spiritual journey, and who are willing to commit to two years of study with an option to complete a four year program.
