RCIA

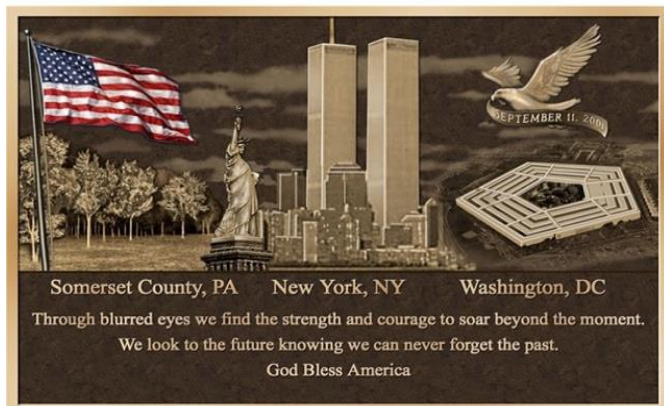
